


ACAUTION

- It is vitally important that you and your pet remain safe during training. Your pet should be on a strong leash that is long enough for him to attempt to chase an object but short enough for him not to reach a road or other unsafe area. You must also be physically strong enough to restrain your pet if he tries to chase.
- This product is not a toy, keep away from children. Use it only for dog training purposes.

CAUTION

- Proper fit of the receiver collar is important. A collar worn for too long or made too tight on a pet's neck may cause skin damage, ranging from redness to pressure ulcers. This condition is commonly known as bed sores.
- Avoid leaving the receiver collar on a pet for more than 12 hours per day.
- When possible reposition the collar on a pet's neck every 1 to 2 hours.
- · Regularly recheck the fit to prevent excessive pressure; follow the instructions in this guide.
- Never connect a leash to the receiver collar; it will cause excessive pressure on the contact points.
- When connecting a leash to a separate collar, do not allow it to put pressure on the receiver collar.
- Wash the pet's neck area and the contact points of the receiver collar weekly with a damp cloth.
- Examine the contact area daily for signs of a rash or a sore.
- If a rash or sore is found, discontinue use of the receiver collar until the skin has healed.
- If the condition persists beyond 48 hours, see your veterinarian.

- This product must be used only on healthy dogs. If you're not certain that your pet is in good health, we recommend that you take your pet to a veterinarian before using this product.

How It works

- Tone: beeps to get your dog's attention or mark a behavior, similar to a clicker
- Vibration: vibrates the receiver collar
- Shock: administers a shock with up to 99 levels of intensity
- 1. To assemble the collar, use the test light tool to screw either the short or long contact points into the holes on the inside of the collar. Ensure the contact points are secure before using the trainer.
- 2. Plug in and fully charge the remote and receiver collar. The battery icon on the remote will cycle while charging and then remain solid when it is fully charged. The collar's LED will be solid red when charging and will turn off when the collar is fully charged.
- 3. To test the collar, ensure that the remote is paired with the collar. Then press the test light tool against the contact points on the collar, and push the action button on the remote while in shock mode. The test light should flash. The higher the intensity of the shock, the brighter the test light will flash.
- 4. With the purchase of a Free Spirit® Add-A-Dog Training Collar, this remote can be paired with two collars. Ensure the remote is on the correct Dog 1/2 setting when pairing a collar, and follow the steps above.
- 5. Make sure that the remote is paired with the correct collar before testing. To test the collar, press the test light tool against the contact points on the collar, and push the action button on the remote while in shock mode. The test light should flash. The higher the intensity of the shock, the brighter the test light will flash.
- 6. If you would like to test the shock level on yourself, place both contact points on your skin, and press the red action button. Both contact points must be touching the skin to emit a shock.
- 7. To assure a proper fit, please follow these steps:
 - a. Start with the collar turned off and your dog standing comfortably, not sitting.
 - b. Place the training collar on your dog's neck with the contact points touching the skin.
 - c. Insert one finger between the collar and your dog's neck to check the tightness. The fit should be snug but not constricting.
 - d. Allow your dog to wear the training collar for several minutes, then recheck the fit. Check the fit again as your dog becomes more comfortable with the training collar.
 - **NOTE:** It is sometimes necessary to trim the hair around the contact area to make sure that contact is consistent. However, you should never shave your pet's neck as this may increase risk of skin irritation.
- 8. The remote has a power-save feature that will put it into standby after 15 minutes without use. Press any button on the remote to reactivate. Note that pressing any of the correction buttons will simultaneously reactivate the remote and send a correction to the receiver collar.
- 9. For your dog's safety, the remote will automatically time-out after 10 seconds of shock. You will have to release and repress the action button to administer another shock.
- *The 330-yard range is based on a straight-line distance between the remote and the receiver collar without obstacles. Interferences in the air, obstacles in the area and other factors could alter the range, so actual distances may vary.
